Today is Home Mission Sunday, a day on which we pray for the work of evangelisation in our own country and remind ourselves that each one of us is called to share our faith. This year's theme is 'A Fresh Wind in Our Sails'. This is what Pope Benedict said his visit last year to the UK gave to him! So today let us thank God for the success of Benedict's visit, just a year ago, and ask the grace for ourselves to witness more confidently to God's love and mercy. There is a retiring collection to help fund the Home Mission Office which offers support and resources to dioceses, parishes, and Catholic organisations around the country. From earliest times Friday has been a day of penance in recognition of Christ's death on the cross on Good Friday. In recent times the Church has required all Catholics between the ages of 14 and 60 to abstain from meat or other food on Fridays or alternatively make some other small sacrifice. Now you may remember that well over a year ago I suggested that we return to observing meatless Fridays not just as a small penance but also to remind ourselves that for most people in this world meat is an indulgence they cannot afford. Also beef is produced by feeding grain to cattle. This increases grain prices causing many in the developing world to go to bed hungry. (The digestive processes of cattle also contribute excessively to global warming!!)

The Bishops of England and Wales have caught up with us and on the anniversary of Pope Benedict's visit invite all Catholics to return to the traditional practice of abstinence from meat on Fridays and so make this once again a distinctive part of our Catholic identity. In this way we not only unite our small sacrifice to the sacrifice of Christ who gave up all for us but we increase awareness of world food poverty and of the plight of the majority of the world's population for whom meat is a luxury.

For various reasons there was a poor attendance at the Parish Forum last Wednesday. However, we adopted the new constitution but deferred the election of a new chairman and secretary until the next Forum which will be held in Sabden on Wednesday, 9th November, at 7.30pm.
