Bereavement Response Group

The parish bereavement response group was formed early this year after awareness was raised of the lack of immediate support from the Parish at the time of a death in a family. The group is made up of parish volunteers who are CRB checked and have time to respond to the needs of the family if wanted. They undertook some basic training which involved discussing and trying to understand grief, looking at the funeral service and particularly the purpose of the requiem Mass and exploring communication and visiting skills.

The purpose of the group is to respond to a parishioner's bereavement through an early visit to the family to express the sympathy of the parish community and to offer support and practical help. Our role is to support the bereaved family through this immediate, difficult time. Fr. John always has a meeting with the family to discuss liturgy but we can give help with this, as well as any practical help that may be needed. When a parishioner dies Fr. John immediately informs one of the group. He will also let one of us know if need arises at any other time following a death. As soon as we hear of a death we telephone the nearest relative on behalf of the parish community, if requested, two of us visit the family.


Since 28th May seventeen families in the parish have suffered the loss of a loved one and have been contacted by members of the group. Almost all have appreciated parish prayers and support. Examples of help that has been given include reading at the funeral service, assisting with the choice of music and readings, some more practical help and follow up visits with support from members of the group. Long term, further support is taken up by the St. Vincent de Paul Society. Mass cards or sympathy cards are sent from the parish community and, whenever possible, one of us attends the funeral service.
