Lots of elbow grease has revealed our magnificent altar-step tiles. The work also uncovered a copy of the Manchester Guardian dated April 20<sup>th</sup> 1880 that carried a report on the war in Afghanistan. Nothing new under the Sun! This week tiles on the sanctuary floor will be cleaned and polished.

\*There will be an ecumenical service hosted by St Paul's, tonight at 6.30, in Low Moor to mark this year's Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. Tomorrow morning at 9 there will be a brief service here in St Michael and St John's.

\*The Royal Blackburn Hospital has expanded to more than 1,000 beds. The chaplain, Fr Paul Blackburn, is keen to build up a body of Catholics willing to help take Holy Communion to patients or simply to visit a Catholic patient in need of company or prayer.
