

Dear Parishioners,

Going by the number of unsolicited comments regarding the new altar, it has met with considerable approval. Though one parishioner commented, 'I need an eye test, I can't see it!' (I am realist enough, however, to recognise that there will be some who disagree and tastes differ) The two candle sticks on either side of the altar were, I suspect, part of the 'big six' that decorated the pre-1950's reredos of the original altar.

The illumination behind the altar's arches is particularly appreciated. Thanks to modern lighting technology the four florescent lights in total burn only 27 watts so they can be left lit the day long for very little cost. An electrician, not a catholic, who spent a day working around the church, commented as he left: "You get a lot of people quietly coming into your church, don't you Father". People, no matter their denomination, are taking advantage of our open church. Hopefully, following three years of requests, the Council will provide clear road signs pointing to the Church and more may then visit our little Gem.

As you know, the old pulpit was intended only for preaching (long sermons in those days) and the book rest was designed to hold sermon notes and not to support large lectionaries, so in a couple of weeks the book rest will be extended and a more sensitive microphone will be installed.

We need more readers and particularly from the younger end of the parish. So, volunteers, please and especially teenagers.

St Mary's Sabden have voted for a bell that has been offered at a reasonable price and permission to install it within the conservation area has been applied for.

You may remember last year's splendid Weld Day celebration.
