Dear Parishioners

In response to a number of requests, handrails have been fitted beside the Presbytery steps, the steps within the side entrance porch and on the spiral stone staircase leading up to the Choir loft. Handrails have also been fixed to the steps to the stage in the parish hall and by the steps from the entrance lobby to the bar area.

A survey conducted when I arrived in Clitheroe four years ago warned that the green floor tiles in the sacristy contained asbestos and that the 160 year old ceiling was in danger of collapse. The tiles didn't pose a health threat but I was advised that they should be removed and also that the ceiling should be replaced before it fell on my head! With urgent work on the church, presbytery and social centre completed, attention has turned to the sacristy. So three weeks ago work began to first remove the tiles, in accordance with government requirements, and then to renew the blown plaster on the sacristy walls and take down or pin back where possible the collapsing ceiling. Coinciding with this, partitions have been removed and rebuilt to improve work areas and increase storage space. Now after three weeks of eating dust the construction work is completed allowing the decorator to begin work this week. And what a relief that is - the fine plaster dust has penetrated every corner of the presbytery and church keeping our voluntary and dedicated team of cleaners on their toes. I'm grateful to them not only for the work but also for their patience!

At the last Forum it was decided that the Special Ministers of Holy Communion (Eucharistic Ministers) who recently completed their training will be commissioned along with the current Ministers who will be recommissioned at the Vigil and Sunday Masses on 3rd and 4th November.

Following the Forum I met in Sabden with a good number of parishioners to discuss matters of specific interest to the Sabden community. It was an excellent meeting that confirmed that the Catholic community of St Mary's is flourishing.

Next week I'll report on the Year of Faith activities both within our parish and the deanery at large.
