Pope Benedict asks Catholics during the *Year of Faith* to use this year to make a real effort to grow in the knowledge of our Faith. In this Deanery we have produced a programme based on a user-friendly version of the Catechism called YOUCAT. Although designed for youth, the YOUCAT is suitable for all ages, explaining Catholic doctrine in clear and simple language that helps us discover the answers to questions about ourselves, God and our relationship with God.

Parishes in the deanery are establishing groups to meet at times convenient to participants to cover these 10 topics.

These groups will not be talking dry theology but dealing with every day important issues. If your image of God is of an old man with a grey beard; does this prevent you relating properly with God? If you are unable to forgive a person a deep hurt they have done you; what are your options?

All participants will be given a copy of YOUCAT, (£9.95 in the shop) for a suggested voluntary donation of £2.


