Dear Parishioners

Today we commemorate the occasion when the Holy Spirit transformed a group of fearful disciples into courageous witnesses to Christ. In a short time thousands were baptised and the Church was established. The miracle of languages that took place on that first Pentecost day demonstrate that from the very beginning the Church was founded to embrace people of every race and country; that she is universal (which is what the name Catholic means) and that she is missionary. To this day at the centre of the Church there remains the beating heart of the Holy Spirit.

Parish Forum met on Wednesday and presumably the poor attendance was the clash with the Europa Football League final?

Nigel Rix opened the meeting with a clear explanation of how the Foodbank came to be and how it will operate. In response Mike Bradley was elected as the parish representative on the charity's executive committee and it was agreed that we take a retiring collection towards its setup costs. This will be on 2nd June. The enterprise needs a posse of volunteers willing to give only a few hours of service one day a week. An excellent Power point presentation gave a clear overview of the parish finances for the past two years. Of interest is that only just over half of our income comes from Sunday collections. More of facts and figures later.

For the past number of years Marina Barrett has faithfully run the parish baptismal preparation course by herself but is looking now for assistance. A couple of volunteers are needed to share the task. If you are interested, please contact me or Marina.

Mike Bradley has been struggling for over four years to coax the Council to provide adequate signs for our church. At the moment there is only one sign that points the wrong way up a one way street! It is important because many visitors to the town (Catholic and non-Catholic alike) are delighted to discover a church that is open. At last Mike has succeeded and we are confident that 5 signs will be erected because we have paid £122 towards their cost! Perseverance! Fr John


