The Muslim fast of Ramadan ended last week with the feast of Id al-Fitr and to mark this important date in the Muslim calendar the Cardinal in charge of the Vatican's office for promoting inter faith relations sends a message of goodwill to Muslims worldwide. This year Pope Francis chose to send this message himself.

In his message, the Pope proposed a topic for common reflection "that concerns both Muslims and Christians: promoting mutual respect through Education."

Emphasising that respect is a reciprocal process, Pope Francis invited Muslims and Christians to respect each and every person "their life, their physical integrity, their dignity and the rights deriving from that dignity, their reputation, their property, their ethnic and cultural identity, their ideas and their political choices. We are therefore called to think, speak and write respectfully of the other, not only in their presence, but always and everywhere, avoiding unfair criticism or defamation. Families, schools, religious teaching and all forms of media have a role to play in achieving this goal."

He continued: "we are called to respect the religion of the other, its teachings, its symbols, its values. Particular respect is due to religious leaders and to places of worship. How painful are attacks on one or other of these!"

"We have to bring up our young people to think and speak respectfully of other religions and their followers, and to avoid ridiculing or denigrating their convictions and practices. I reiterate my hope that all Christians and Muslims may be true promoters of mutual respect and friendship, in particular through education."

He concluded; "I send you my prayerful good wishes, that your lives may glorify the Almighty and give joy to those around you. Happy Feast to you all!"

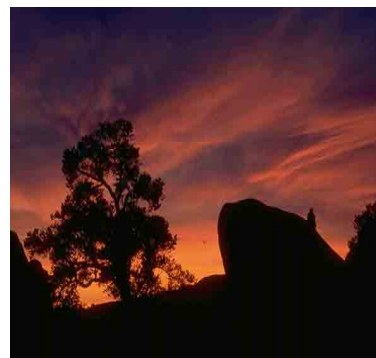
