Dave Hardman of Christian Aid will highlight the steps which can be taken to achieve lasting change. 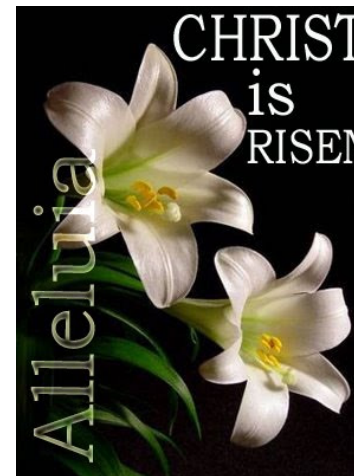

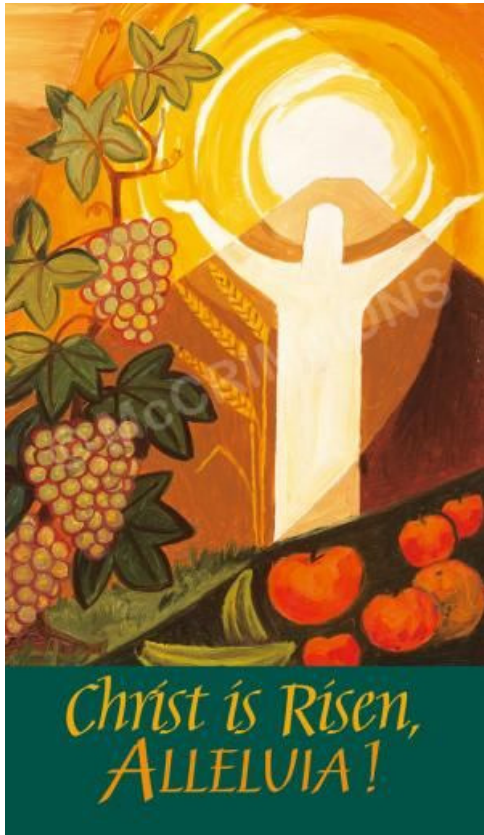
