

REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY—10th November

Next weekend Masses will be as normal in Clitheroe
Saturday—5pm and Sunday 9.30am

The Civic events, organised by Clitheroe Town Council begin at 9.10am with a procession, led by the Town Crier and Clitheroe Town Band, from the Town Hall via Church St, Wellgate, Lowergate, King Lane, Market Place and Church St to St Mary's. The service will commence at 9.30am and conclude at 10.30am. There will then be a second procession from St Mary's to the Cenotaph via Church St, Market Place, Castle St and Castlegate. The Service of Remembrance, conducted by the Rev Andy Froud will begin at 10.45am and will incorporate the two minutes silence at 11am. At the conclusion of the service there will then be a short procession to The United Reformed Church, Castlegate where refreshments will be served.

In Sabden Mass will be at 11.30am to enable parishioners to attend the 11am service at the village Cenotaph

In Dunsop Bridge there will be a short service at the Cenotaph at 10.50am followed by refreshments in Dunsop Bridge Village Hall.

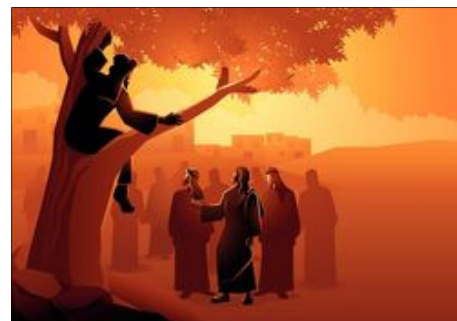
