We are looking for you to invite a refugee or asylum seeking family as guests for a meal in your home. We hope this will make them feel welcome, and add to their understanding of England and our way of life, at the same time as giving you a better understanding what it's like to be a refugee or asylum seeker.

Then return it to Janet Clegg at the Parish Office or post it in the box at the back of Church.

We send you the contact information. You get in touch and make your own arrangements with the guest family. As well as a meal, you might want to show them a local beauty spot or interesting historic building near your home? Please bear in mind that they will have no money and no transport, so you need to arrange to collect them and drop them back where they live, provide food, and cover the costs of anything you do during your time as a host.

It's OK to say "No"

Like you, your guests will have things they don't want to talk about-they may have painful experiences they don't want to re-live.

No commitment.

To keep it sustainable, both guests and hosts agree not to solicit, advertise, or request any product or service whatever or enter into an into any kind of job, work, or support related arrangements.
