SYNOD 2021-2023 Commenced 17 October For a synodal Church: Communion Participation, Mission, Pope Francis has described the upcoming Synod as a journey in which the whole Church is engaged. The Synod will take place between October 2021 and October 2023, and the itinerary has been conceived as 'a dynamism of mutual listening, conducted at all levels of the Church, involving the whole people of God'. The first stage of the process (October 2121—April 2022) is the one concerning the individual diocesan Churches. Each local church will be sent details for a consultation and listening process that must last until April 2022 when a diocese will be required to submit proposals to their bishops' conference. We are waiting for further instructions and information from the diocese, then we can make known how we can move forward as a parish and as a diocese.


